BULKY ITEMS, ELECTRONIC WASTE, & WHITE GOODS

Items that cannot properly fit in your container, such as a chair or desk, are considered bulky items and require a special pick up. Electronic waste [e-Waste] is anything with a circuit board or battery, such as computers, telephones and small printers. White goods [e.g. refrigerators, freezers] and electronic waste cannot be disposed of in your container. CR&R will collect and properly recycle these items. Multi-family dwelling unit customers are eligible for four (4) pickups per unit per calendar year at no extra cost. Contact customer service to schedule pickups.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Hazardous wastes are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive or toxic. They are dangerous to the public and the environment. It is illegal to dispose of hazardous wastes in your CR&R containers. Hazardous wastes must be disposed of properly.

Bowerman Landfill in Irvine and Capistrano Greenery at Prima Deshecha Landfill in San Juan Capistrano https://oclandfills.com/compost **Assembly Bill 939** [AB 939] required jurisdictions to meet diversion goals of 25% by 1995 and 50% by the year 2000.

Assembly Bill 341 [AB 341] required all jurisdictions to meet the diversion goal of 75% by 2020 resulting in businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of waste per week to either:

- Participate in a recycling program with their local waste hauler.
- Donate, sell and/or self-haul materials to a recycling facility.

ASSEMBLY Bill 1826 [AB 1826] requires businesses to separate their food scraps and green waste for recycling. AB 1826 builds on the success of the mandatory commercial recycling program established by AB 341. All businesses with 2 or more yards of solid waste per week must either:

- Participate in an organic recycling program with their local waste hauler.
- Donate, sell and/or self-haul materials to an organic recycling facility.
- Compost organic materials

Governor Brown signed SB 1383 In September 2016
Governor Brown signed SB 1383 establishing methane emissions reduction targets in a statewide effort to reduce emissions. In accordance to this law, all local jurisdictions must provide organic waste collection services to all residential and commercial generators by January 1, 2022, to divert this material from local landfills. Organic waste includes food scraps and green waste such as landscape and pruning waste.

MIXED RECYCLING

This program recycles materials such as: cardboard, mixed paper, plastic, aluminum and glass bottles. They may be mixed together and placed in a recycling bin.



CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION

With construction and demolition [C&D] debris making up a large percentage of all material entering California landfills, CR&R can help you to divert as much as possible through a combination of source separation and mixed processing. Prior to starting your project, contact CR&R to find out what options will work best for your site. Planning ahead will assist you in diverting as much material as possible, as cost effectively as possible.



CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

CR&R's Annual Christmas Tree and Holiday Greenery Recycling Program is an excellent way for apartment complexes, town homes, and home owners associations to effectively deal with the removal of additional holiday green waste and eliminate overflow problems with your dumpsters. Your property can schedule to have a delivery of a roll-off bin to collect holiday

green waste for recycling. The container would remain on site through New Year's with a removal date the following week or later if requested. If the container becomes full prior to the removal date, you may call our Customer Service Department to order an exchange.
