## What Can Be Recycled?

Residents often ask what can be placed in the mixed-recycle cart. CR&R accepts a variety of glass, metal, plastic, and paper.

# What Can Be Recycled?

Senate Bill 1383 requires all cities in California to recycle as well as reduce organic waste by 75% by January 1, 2025. Many times, contaminated materials are accidentally put into the recycling or organics carts. When an item is deemed contaminated it is removed and sent to the landfill. Even the smallest amount of contamination can cause recyclable items to be deemed contaminated. To help reduce the number of recyclables sent to the landfill, please see the guide below.

DO 	DON'T 
<b>DO</b> Scrape and rinse out containers so that they can be recycled 	<b>DON'T</b> Leave food residue on the inside 
<b>DO</b> Call CR&R for information and pricing for additional containers 	<b>DON'T</b> Throw trash into your recycling cart when your landfill container is full 
<b>DO</b> Empty all liquid out of containers to prevent paper items from being contaminated 	<b>DON'T</b> Throw away partially full beverages, cartons, or detergent containers 
<b>DO</b> Place your recyclables directly into your cart 	<b>DON'T</b> Bag your recyclables 
<b>DO</b> use only compostable bags or no bags inside your organics cart 	<b>DON'T</b> Put grocery store or plastic bags in the organics cart

### Holiday Schedule: Non-Collection Days

**New Year's Day   Memorial Day   Independence Day   Labor Day   Thanksgiving Day   Christmas Day**

If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, trash will be collected on your normal collection day with no delays to your pickup. If the holiday falls during the work week, collection for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. For example, if Independence Day falls on a Monday, and your normal collection day is on a Thursday, your pickup for that week will be on Friday.
