

### REMEMBER ON COLLECTION DAY



- 1 The carts should be placed at the curbside no later than 6:30 am on collection day and removed from the curbside within 12 hours after service.
- 2 The carts should be placed with the handles and wheels facing towards your home.
- 3 Place carts side-by-side approximately 1 foot apart & at least 3 feet from any obstruction (i.e. vehicles, fire hydrants, trees).
- 4 Items placed outside of carts will not be collected. Cart lids should be closed. Please do not overload.

### ITEMS FOR RECYCLING CART

- Glass
- Plastic
- Metal
- Paper
- Flattened Cardboard



### ITEMS FOR ORGANICS CART

- Meat / Fish / Dairy
- Fruits / Vegetables
- Bread / Grains / Pasta
- Coffee Grounds
- Food Scraps
- Food-Soiled Paper
- · Grass / Leaves
- Flowers / Weeds
- Prunings / Wood



### ITEMS FOR LANDFILL CART

- Mixed Products (i.e. Plastic/Metal Combination)
- Waxed Paper
- Coated Products
- Diapers
- Ceramic / Pyrex
- Pet Waste
- Clothes Hampers
- Styroafoam / Polystyrene
- Palm Fronds

No Toxic, No Hazardous Waste, No Batteries, etc.



## TEMPORARY COLLECTIONS

Larger waste collection containers (from 3 yards to 40 yards) are available for clean-up projects and other disposal needs. If a container will be placed on a public street, please contact the City of Laguna Niguel for an encroachment permit (prior

### ADDITIONAL SERVICES AVAILABLE

#### **BULKY ITEMS**

Items that cannot fit in your automated carts are considered bulky items. Bulky items must be manageable by a two-person crew. You may arrange for free bulky item collection up to three (3) times per year with a maximum of four (4) items per collection. Additional pick-ups may be arranged for a nominal charge. To arrange for a pick-up, click on Bulky or E-waste at <a href="www.crrwasteservices.com">www.crrwasteservices.com</a> or call customer service at 877,728,0446.

Examples of Bulky Items include:

- Miscellaneous Furniture
- \*E-Waste
- Bundled Cardboard

- Excessive green waste
- Washer and Dryer
- \*Refrigerator
- \*Refrigerator or household appliances containing Freon and other chemicals require special handling and may carry an additional charge.
- \*Electronic Waste (e-waste) is anything with a circuit board or battery powered. It is illegal to dispose of e-waste in any of your automated carts. CR&R will collect and legally dispose of and recycle these items. Examples include monitors, televisions, computers, cell phones, printers.

Hazardous wastes are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive or toxic. Discarded batteries are hazardous waste in California. Therefore, it is illegal to dispose of them in regular trash or recycling; so don't place them in any of your collection containers. This includes batteries of all types and sizes: Alkaline (AAA, AA, C, D, 9 volt), Lithium-ion (button cell, power tool batteries, camera batteries, other electronics), Ni-Cad (power tools), rechargeable and single use. Batteries can be collected as part of your service or taken to one of the County of Orange Household Hazardous Waste drop off centers.

Why is it important? When lithium-ion batteries are improperly disposed of they can cause fires in recycling centers, landfills, and garbage and recycling trucks.



You may use one of the County of Orange Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) drop off centers to properly dispose of any HHW. For hours of operation or more information on County of Orange Household Hazardous Waste centers and landfills, contact at 714-834-6752 or www.oclandfills.com.

Examples of HHW include:

- Fluorescent light tubes
- Household batteries
- Latex or water based paint

- Non empty aerosol cans
- Thermostats
- High intensity discharge lamp

# **SHARPS**

Disposal of needles, lancets and other home-generated sharps in your trash and recycling bins is hazardous and illegal. These items may be collected in an approved puncture proof container and recycled through local pharmacies.
