## REMEMBER ON COLLECTION DAY

- 1 The carts should be placed at the curbside no later than 6:30 am on collection day and removed from the curbside within 12 hours after service.
- 2 The carts should be placed with the handles and wheels facing towards your home.
- 3 Place carts side-by-side approximately 1 foot apart & at least 3 feet from any obstruction (i.e. vehicles, fire hydrants, trees).
- 4 Items placed outside of carts will not be collected. Cart lids should be closed. Please do not overload.

## ITEMS FOR RECYCLING CART

- Glass
- Plastic
- Metal
- Paper



## ITEMS FOR GREEN WASTE CART

- Grass Clippings
- Garden Trimmings
- Weeds
- Flowers
- Wood Scraps / Chips
- Green Plants
- Dry Leaves



\*Palm fronds are not recyclable and should be placed in your landfill cart.

- Must be 62 years of age or older
- Must be head of household
- Must be on social security benefits

## BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

Items that cannot fit in your automated carts are considered bulky items. Bulky items must be manageable by a two-person crew.

Examples of Bulky Items include:

***Couches • Tables • Desks • Mattresses • Chairs • Excessive green waste***

A bulky item service may include a combination of large items or bags of materials. Please contact customer service for more information.

## WHITE GOODS

White Goods or household appliances containing Freon are picked up similar to a bulky item. Refrigerators contain Freon and other chemicals that require special handling. CR&R will collect bulky items and white goods from your curbside.

## E-WASTE

Electronic Waste (e-waste) is anything with a circuit board or battery powered. It is illegal to dispose of e-waste in any of your automated carts. CR&R will collect and legally dispose of and recycle these items via our bulky item collection service. Examples include monitors, televisions, computers, cell phones, printers.

Hazardous wastes are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive or toxic. Discarded batteries are considered hazardous waste in California. Therefore, it is illegal to dispose of them in regular trash or recycling; so don't place them in CR&R containers. This includes batteries of all types and sizes Alkaline (AAA, AA, C, D, 9 volt), Lithium (button cell, power tool batteries, camera batteries, other electronics), Ni-Cad (power tools), and battery types both rechargeable and single use.

**Why is it important? When lithium batteries are improperly disposed of they can cause fires in recycling centers, landfills, and garbage and recycling trucks.**

Sharps disposal mail-back containers are available upon request at no charge. The mail-back container allows residents to safely and properly dispose of sharps waste including needles, injector pens, and syringes.
