

Welcome to your new Organics Recycling Program!

On July 1st, 2021, CR&R Environmental Services together with the City of Tustin will launch a new Organics Recycling Program. Your green waste container will now accept food scraps in addition to yard waste. An organics decal sticker will be placed on the lid of your green waste container outlining acceptable materials. The collected organic material will be delivered to one of CR&R's compost facilities where it will be converted to compost. This new co-collection program will divert your organic material away from landfills.

Organics Decal

Placement begins the week of July 12th, 2021 and will continue for several weeks.



Organics Cart

Your current green waste container NOW accepts organic material from your yard and kitchen.



Kitchen Food Scrap Container

Distribution of the Kitchen Food Scrap Container to your doorstep begins in July and will continue for several weeks.

Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383)

In September 2016, Governor Brown signed SB 1383 establishing methane emissions reduction targets in a statewide effort to reduce emissions. In accordance with this law, all jurisdictions must provide organic waste collection services to all residential and commercial customers by January 1, 2022 to ensure organic material is diverted from the landfills. Organic waste includes food scraps, green waste such as landscaping, and pruning waste.



Tips For Using Your Organics Cart

- Start with yard trimmings such as leaves, grass clippings and/or straw at the bottom of your organics cart to prevent food scraps from being trapped.
- Alternate layering of food scraps and yard trimmings will help keep your cart cleaner.
- Keep your organics cart dry and out of direct sunlight to reduce odor.
- Compostable bags are optional and available at local retailers. Other types of bags are not accepted.



- Store your cart in the shade during warm weather.
- Keep your food scraps in the freezer until collection day.
- Sprinkle baking soda in your organics cart.
- Place a layer of yard materials, cardboard or newspaper at the bottom of your organics cart before adding food scraps.

Holiday Schedule: Non-Collection Days

If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, trash will be collected on your normal collection day with no delays to your pickup. If the holiday falls during the work week, collection for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. For example, if Independence Day falls on a Monday, and your normal collection day is on a Thursday, your pickup for that week will be on Friday.
