Dry Recycling Collection

Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) and Assembly Bill 341 (AB 341) require all jurisdictions to support the statewide goal of 75% diversion from landfill. Per Orange Municipal Code 8.29.220, all multi-family complexes are required to participate in recycling programs.

CR&R provides convenient dry recycling collection services along with the training and resources necessary for successful implementation.

Each multifamily unit is allowed 6 bulky item pickups per year (up to 4 items per pickup) at no additional charge.

Senate Bill 1383: Organic Waste Reduction

Senate Bill 1383 and Orange Municipal Code 8.30.030 requires all multi-family complexes to participate in their jurisdiction's organics collection programs in order to reduce landfill waste and pollution. CR&R provides convenient organic waste collection services for organic waste generators along with the training and resources necessary for successful implementation.

YES

Place the following items in your organic waste container:

- All food preparation scraps
- Solidified fats or greases
- Food soiled paper
- All table scraps
- Spoiled food
- Green/Yard Waste

Provide information to new tenants within 14 days of occupation of the premises. CR&R can provide samples of the necessary outreach materials.

Annually educate tenants on how to properly sort organic waste into the correct bins. CR&R is available to assist in any training program.

NO

Do NOT place the following in your organic waste collection container:

- Plastic
- Glass
- Metal
- Liquids
- Styrofoam
- Trash
- Paper

Do not overfill container. Food waste is much heavier than regular trash.



Helpful Tip: Bagging food waste for collection with clear or compostable liners is recommended. Liners can help maintain a clean container and minimize odors.
